1) If PRT needs more details, it is PRT's responsibility to specify with clarifying questions or statements. Asking me to speculate on what details PRT might, or might not need, to acquire full understanding on what PRT might, or might not, understand, is a proposition that, predictably, comes from a lack of expertise and experience in operations. Lawyers rarely (I don't know, nor have I heard of any instances) have training or experience in operations.

2) If PRT specified the details needed to acquire 'full' understanding, Ms. Cushman and other PRT employees would have to consider and process these new details before forming the 'full understanding' that can't be had without said details. Asking me to expend my time waiting around in Columbia for PRT to form the newer, fuller, understanding is a waste of my time and another basic meeting faux pas.

3) If PRT already understands what I have repeatedly communicated, asking me to spend my time speculating on what details to gather for discussion, when PRT knows this gathering and discussion would serve no purpose, is a waste of my time and taxpayer funded PRT time.

Surely someone at PRT has experience in non-speculative, results driven, data managed, operational management. If PRT has a specific non-speculative reason a physical meeting is required, please disclose so I can consider. In the absence of questions or specific indications, it is a reasonable presumption my prior correspondence and website documents are fully understood by PRT.
